



# MUSD Digital Driver's License for students new to MUSD

New to MUSD? Before you get your digital device, you need your digital driver's license. Like someone new to the road, this is a provisional license to get you started. You will receive more practice and instruction as the year goes on.

**To get your Digital Driver's License, you must complete 3 assessments.**

This can be done together in a group, led by a DST, Teacher, or other designated adult.

Together, you answer the questions, and learn from the interactive assessment. If you don't get them all right, that is OK! You are still learning.
