We will again be selling slushies on Thursdays for 50¢ each right after school. We will sell them out of the new cafeteria in the gym. We are looking for volunteers to help do this on Thursdays

**Honor Banquet**

It was reported that Mrs. Greene along with Shasta Community Club would like to extend the Black & Gold Honor banquet to include 4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grades. All of these children who earn a 3.5 grade point average or above would attend this banquet. Currently we have \$500 earmarked for this event so we will need to fundraise in order to cover the expenses of expanding the banquet. This item will be an action item at the next meeting.

**Mural on the Multi-Purpose room**

There has been some suggestion of painting some type of mural on the outside of the new multi-purpose building. WE have to be careful of our neighbors and as Mrs. Greene pointed out we need to check with the district to see what if anything is allowed. Moving forward we need to determine the following:

**Naming of the Multi-purpose room**

The district is putting together a naming committee for the new multipurpose room. Helen Hankal-Jackson and Rosemarie Craighead have shown an interest in being the parent representatives.
