



# COVID-19 QUICK GUIDE

## A FLOWCHART FOR PARENTS

### IF YOUR CHILD TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Complete your child's daily Self-Screening Survey and indicate that they have tested positive for COVID-19. The survey will direct your child to isolate at home and give guidance on next steps.

Contact your child's school to determine where to send positive test results and for distance learning opportunities.  
**Failure to contact your child's school may result in unexcused absences.**

Your child can return to school as early as Day 6 into their isolation period with a negative test result collected on/after Day 5 if they do not have symptoms. If your child chooses to test, contact their school to determine where to send negative results.

If unable to test, your child must isolate at home through Day 10, and may return to school on Day 11 if they do not have symptoms.

### IF YOUR CHILD HAS SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19

Complete your child's daily Self-Screening Survey and indicate that they are showing symptoms. The survey will direct your child to isolate at home and give guidance on next steps.

Contact your child's school for distance learning opportunities.  
**Failure to contact your child's school may result in unexcused absences.**

Your child can return to school as early as Day 6 into their isolation period with a negative test result collected on/after Day 5 and symptoms are improving. If your child chooses to test, contact their school to determine where to send negative results.

If unable to test, your child must isolate at home through Day 10, and may return to school on Day 11 if they are fever-free and feeling better.

### IF YOUR CHILD WAS EXPOSED TO COVID-19

Complete your child's daily Self-Screening Survey and indicate that they have been exposed to COVID-19. The survey will ask additional questions that will determine if your child can continue to come to school.

If your child receives a green check mark from their survey, they can continue coming to school. If they receive a Red X, they must stay at home. Contact your child's school for distance learning opportunities.  
**Failure to contact your child's school may result in unexcused absences.**

Your child can return to school as early as Day 6 into their isolation period with a negative test result collected on/after Day 5 and do not have symptoms. If your child chooses to test, contact their school to determine where to send negative results.

If unable to test, your child must isolate at home through Day 10, and may return to school on Day 11 if they do not have any symptoms.
