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Community Update

This Spring Break allows for our staff to reevaluate and effectively coordinate actions upon our projected return. This decision was made to assist in flattening the curve to stagger the number of COVID-19 cases over a longer period of time. This allows health care providers to maximize their ability to respond to respiratory issues.

School activities scheduled to take place during this suspension period will be cancelled or postponed. Please wait for specific information pertaining to any pre-scheduled event. We understand there are still many questions surrounding future school events such as prom or graduation, and we will provide those answers as soon as they become available.

We do not anticipate an extension to the school year at this time.

We want to thank our Operations team for their commitment to our students during this trying time. They continue to deep clean classrooms, restrooms, offices, and other common areas with increased methods and devices per state-recommendation.

While our school facilities will be closed, **children in our community ages 2-18 will be able to pick up free breakfast (for next day) and lunch at any of our comprehensive school sites Monday-Friday between 11:30am-12:30pm.** Families will be able to “grab and go” lunch and breakfast (for the next day) for their child(ren) in front of each school site except for New Vision High School, Calla High School, Great Valley Annex (main site will be serving), and BE.Tech High School. All students may go to the closest school to their home. All meals are FREE.

We thank our staff who are working tirelessly to help our students and plan for our community to stay connected during this difficult time. We know our staff are an important part of students’ lives and we will do our best to maintain that connection during this health crisis. Thank you to our village, our community, for coming together in a time of uncertainty and having patience with one another as we weather this time together.
