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Dear MUSD Families and Community,

In previous communication, we announced our commitment to a distance learning model through May 15, 2020, with the highest hope of returning to our physical classrooms on May 18th to finish the school year together. However, notices from county, state and health officials recommend that all schools in California remain closed to on-site education for the remainder of the 2019/20 school year. In order to plan for the needs and stability for our students and staff, this afternoon, MUSD Board of Trustees made the decision to **extend school campus closure through July 30, 2020.**

We recognize schools are critical to the daily lives and well-being of students. We will continue to deliver meal service and educational opportunities to our students. The school year is not over, and learning does not cease. Manteca Unified will continue to improve and deliver the existing distance learning model. We appreciate the patience of our families as our educators and students have transitioned to a new way of learning.

We are continuing to communicate with our graduating and promoting students and families. Further information on next steps for end of year ceremonies will be conveyed shortly.
