
The Manteca Unified School District ("District") and the Manteca Educators' Association ("MEA") hereby enter into this Amendment No. 5 to the Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") dated September 17, 2020.

The District and MEA recognize the continued impact COVID 19 had on public education and the working conditions of the employees. The Parties also recognize the challenges of administering CAASPP at the secondary sites in an efficient manner that minimizes the loss of instructional minutes.


To these ends, the District and MEA agree as follows:

1. Members assigned to secondary sites may volunteer to administer the CAASPP on Distance Learning Wednesday. Those teachers who volunteer will waive the opportunity to work from home on Wednesdays designated for CAASPP administration. They agree to take attendance for both their regular classes and the CAASPP administration class and provide an asynchronous lesson for their regular classes.
2. In return for working from campus and monitoring both classes, the district agrees to additional compensation using the criteria below:
 - a. Receive 2 hours of non-student contact rate for CAASPP training.
 - b. Receive 3 hours of student contact rate for preparation time associated with creating lessons for D.L. while administering the CAASPP assessment.


