Further, my parent/guardian and I have been advised that Manteca Unified School District, and the school site do not have control of the information on the Internet, although it attempts to provide prudent and available barriers. Other sites accessible via the Internet may contain material that is illegal, defamatory, inaccurate, or potentially offensive to some people. While the District’s intent is to make Internet access available to further school and District educational goals and objectives, account holders will have the ability to access materials which may not be appropriate and meet these goals and objectives. The District believes that the benefits to students to access the Internet, in the form of information resources and opportunities for collaboration, far exceed any disadvantages of access. But ultimately, the parent/guardian of minors are responsible for setting and conveying the standards that their student should follow. To that end, District, and school supports and respects each family’s right to decide whether or not to apply for Manteca Unified School District Data Processing Network (MUSDNet) access. The District and school make no warranties of any kind, whether express or implied, for the services it is providing. The District will not be responsible for any damages a user suffers.
