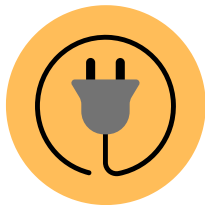

Frequently Asked Questions

What other benefits can my child receive by completing the form?

Students may receive reduced or waived college application fees, SAT/ACT registration fees, AP testing fees, costs associated with dual credit courses, extracurricular fees associated with electives such as art or band, and reduced internet and PG&E cost. We are encouraging every household to complete the alternative income form. With this unprecedented worldwide crisis, we understand many have become unemployed or lost income.

I have already filled out the free and reduced lunch application this year, do I need to complete the survey?

This form replaces the free/reduced meal application. Even if you've previously been approved using the free/reduced meal application, please take a moment to complete the alternative income form.

How will forms be distributed and collected?

Confidential Family Surveys will be available to take online at www.mantecausd.net/completeaif. Paper copies will be mailed to every MUSD household.

If you complete the paper form, please return the form to your school office. Call the school office to request an additional paper copy.

When do I need to complete the form?

Complete the form as soon as possible. Forms need to be completed by **December 11, 2020**.

I completed and submitted the form, what do I do now?

The information submitted on the form will be kept on your student's file during their time with MUSD. If eligible, any internal fees such as extracurricular fees, or class fees will automatically be waived.

To find out about external benefits such as waived SAT/ACT registration fees, please contact the Nutrition Education Department at (209) 858-0804 and request more information.

What is a CEP site?

A CEP site is a school that qualifies for CEP meal status based on the number of students who are directly certified to receive free meals per their participation in CalFresh, CalWorks, Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR), or Head Start programs or who are identified as homeless, foster, migrant, or runaway as a percentage of total site enrollment.

Schools that qualify as a CEP in MUSD have been notified.
