

SIERRA HIGH SCHOOL VEHICLE REGISTRATION FORM

Driving to school must be considered a privilege. Failure to abide by the following rules may result in the loss of this privilege and/or disciplinary measures imposed by the school.

1. The student must possess a valid California driver's license and obey all California driving laws.
2. The student and vehicle must be covered by insurance which meets California law for financial responsibility.
3. **Student must provide a copy of proof of insurance, attached to this form. The school will not be responsible for making a copy of insurance card.**
4. The student and his parents /guardians must assume liability for damage to school property.
5. The school cannot be responsible for damage or loss to any vehicle brought to school.
6. The student must park in the prescribed parking area in the spaces designated for students. This includes motorized two-wheeled vehicles.
7. Vehicles are to be parked and not used during the school day except at lunch with an approved off-campus pass and when prior approval has been granted by a parent/ guardian and the school.
8. Vehicles may not be used to transport other students off campus without authorization from parents.
9. A parking permit which is required, must be displayed as prescribed by the school, but not in violation of the California Motor Vehicle Code.
10. A student driver must abide by the California Motor Vehicle Code and Sierra parking regulations (see back of this page).
11. Students are not at any time allowed to enter the parking lot after parking without a pass and may not use their car as a locker to retrieve books in between classes or to sit in your car at lunch time for any reason.

Parking Your Car At Sierra High School

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Pursuant to Vehicle Code 21113, the parking regulations of Sierra High School are as follows:

1. Parking is reserved for school use by students, school employees, and guests only.
2. All vehicles must be registered with the Administration Office, and the SHS parking permit must be visibly displayed. Penalties for not having the vehicle registered or not displaying the permit are as follows:
 - a. Citations will result in a fine of \$22 to \$275 depending on the violations. These are tickets issued by the Manteca Police Department.
 - b. Continued infractions may result in revoking of driving privilege to school.
3. Parking outside of lines or in unauthorized areas may result in referral to the Manteca Police Department for appropriate action.
4. Violators may be towed at the owner's expense.
5. While respecting the rights of responsible students to drive their cars to school with parental permission, the school also realizes that it is responsible for the safety and welfare of all students; therefore, during the school day on or around the school grounds and at all school-related functions, students who drive recklessly, break traction, or speed will be penalized.
 - a. Each time a student is referred for a violation the penalty(ies) will increase in severity.
 - b. Penalties include detention, work detail, Saturday School and suspension.
 - c. Loss of driving privileges might also be included as a penalty.
 - d. Parents will also be notified of such violations.
6. Manteca Unified School District currently participates in a preventive program aimed at keeping drugs, illegal weapons, gangs and tobacco off campus. By entering the parking lot, the person in charge of any vehicle consents to search of the entire vehicle and its contents with or without cause by school officials or police officers. Any student or guest who violates any of these policies is subject to arrest by the Manteca Police Dept. and/or school suspension/expulsion.

These regulations are important to insure the safety of all who come to Sierra High School.
