

## **Sierra High School Peer Resource Conduct Agreement**

All Sierra High School Peer Resource members are expected to adhere to the standards of behavior outlined in the California Association of Peer Programs (CAPP) "Ethics and Standards for Peer Programs." A code of ethics is an agreement among individuals about norms which shall guide their behavior and are a minimum standard of behavior for peer helpers/counselors.

In addition to these expectations, students are expected to maintain the following standards:

1. Academic eligibility of minimum of 2.0 GPA. No grades lower than C- at any time and no Unsatisfactory Citizenship grades.
2. Be tobacco-free, alcohol-free, and drug-free.
3. Follow all school rules throughout the school day.
  - No individual suspensions of more than 1 day in length.
  - Total days of suspension not to exceed 1 per year.
4. Participate in all activities expected of students in the class.
5. Use class time as assigned. Maintain required records.

Any Peer Resource member who fails to adhere to the CAPP standards or maintain the standards listed above may be removed from the Peer Resource class/program.
